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
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I appreciate the school communication with email. I have struggled with not being able to enter the school to interact with teachers and admin staff. To further develop a relationship with teachers and staff.

Grade 7 FI PSAA only had 4 peers to interact with during class and recess time. At a junior high age, students need a large group of peers to interact with. Only having a few peers within a grade can be isolating.





There needs to be more communication at the school level. The newsletters are too short. As a working parent it is hard to connect with the school about school wide pieces.
