Please see the information below about the student drop-off area. This is the **ONLY** location families should be dropping off students. **The area by the front park is NOT a safe drop off zone as busses are coming throughout the morning time.** Please also be respectful of our neighbors and avoid blocking driveways.

ÉBPS: How to Navigate our Student Drop Off/Pick Up Lane



This map shows the direction to follow when dropping off or picking up your child. It is highly important that all parents operate their vehicles in a safe and efficient manner. Please be cautious, considerate and courteous to your fellow Broxton families when navigating through this lane by driving carefully. Winter conditions will require extra attention!

Things to remember:

1- The right lane in **red** is the only area where you are permitted to stop your vehicle so that your child or children can embark or disembark your vehicle safely. Parents are not permitted to leave a vehicle unattended in this lane. Should you wish to meet your child at his or her designated door, then you are to use the parking area or church lot across the street. The Drop Off/Pick Up lane is efficiently designed to run with the least amount of stopping possible for a quick pick up or drop off.

2- **The Exit lane**, in **green**, is a **no-stopping** lane. Parents are not to park or stop in this lane to drop off or pick up their child as vehicles are driving in this lane. Should you need to park, use the right lane.

3- From the parking lot area, please have your child proceed to the designated **crosswalk**, where a supervisor can ensure they safely cross both lanes. Crossing at other parts of the parking lot to the school grounds may not be a safe practice, especially when the ground is slippery due to snow and ice in the winter months. The crosswalk is marked with orange pylons so please proceed with caution to have enough stopping distance prior to the crosswalk. In addition, please refrain from parking on the crosswalk as this prevents students and families from crossing safely.

Thank you for your cooperation in running the Parent Student Drop Off/Pick Up lane smoothly.
