

Remembrance Day

The 11th day of the 11th month is Remembrance Day. We wear a poppy and gather at cenotaphs and memorials in cities, towns and villages throughout the country and bow our heads. We take part in a simple, but very moving ceremony to honor the many Canadians who were involved in World War I, World War II, the Korean War and United Nations peacekeeping operations throughout the world.

École Broxton Park School will have a Remembrance Day assembly on Friday, November 8 at 10:30 a.m. in the gymnasium. There will be class presentations, a procession of service groups and laying of wreaths followed by the observation of a minute of silence. Parents and family are invited to attend. By participating in Remembrance Day services we ensure that our society continues to honour and remember all those who have served and are serving in times of war, military conflict and peace. Students involved in community service groups (Cadets, Girl Guides, Scouts, etc.) are invited to dress in their uniform for the assembly and be part of the procession that will represent past, present, and future peacekeepers.
